GUIDELINES FOR APPLICATIONS

The Scholarship Committee solicits applications from people who are studying or in training programs, and who are or will be making a direct contribution to the grape-growing industry of the State of Washington. In accordance with the bylaws of the Scholarship Memorial Fund, the winner will be announced at the November annual meeting of the Washington State Grape Society.

Application must include:

1. **LETTER OF APPLICATION:** This letter addressed to the Scholarship Committee, is the most important item in the image you wish to present. It should include why you want an education and the academic area in which you plan to study. Briefly outline your area of interest and indicate how the results can contribute to the Washington grape industry, including a statement of your perception of your long term contributions to the industry.
2. **PERSONAL INFORMATION SHEET:** Its purpose is to help the Scholarship Committee learn about you as a student and as a member of your community. It also gives a picture of your future plans. Be very careful completing this form. Provide the most accurate information you have available. The committee relies heavily on the information contained in this form.
3. **TRANSCRIPTS:** Please request transcripts of your academic record from all colleges and universities attended to be sent to: Washington State Grape Society, 100 N. Fruitland St., Suite B, Kennewick, WA 99336. "Official" transcripts will be accepted, but not required. A photo copy of transcripts is permitted.
4. **THREE LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION:** Include one from the applicant's academic adviser, the remaining letters should be requested from people who are well acquainted with you as a student and as a person.
